## NHLTA Education Committee – Annual report 2024-2025

The 2025 annual conference was the focus of the 2024-2025 year. It was co-chaired by Tammy Hooker and Janet Hromjak and held at the Doubletree Hotel in Manchester, NH. The theme of the conference was "Trustees Unleashed: The Must-Have Info!" The keynote topic, "The Courage to Put on the Cape: How Library Trustees Can Harness Their Power for Good," was delivered by Kelly Jensen, editor of Book Riot. There were 15 concurrent sessions and 29 sponsors. DrummondWoodsum was the premier sponsor. Participants were encouraged to visit all vendors and have their passport stamped for it to be entered into a drawing for a cash gift card. Breakfast, a plated lunch and a cookie break were served. Next year's conference will be held on May 27, 2026

Several regional gatherings were scheduled for this year. Chesterfield Public Library hosted a gathering on April 9<sup>th</sup> and 37 people attended. The Newbury/Pillsbury libraries held a gathering on May 12<sup>th</sup> and 39 people attended.
