

MILDRED McKAY SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The NHLTA Board of Directors believes that continuing education is a prime factor in providing the highest quality of library services. The Mildred McKay Scholarship Fund provides a way to improve library services within the state.

In 1965, the NHLTA established the Mildred McKay Scholarship Fund in honor of the former NH State Librarian. The New Hampshire Charitable Foundation manages the perpetual endowment and distributes funds to the NHLTA Board of Directors to be awarded as scholarships on an annual basis.

There are two different scholarships available:

Conference or Workshop Scholarship

To encourage trustee and library staff education, scholarships to NHLTA, NHMA, NHLA, NELA, and ALA conferences or workshops are offered to NHLTA members.

Graduate Studies Scholarship

Applicant must be currently employed by a NH library, full or part-time, and enrolled in an ALA accredited school of Library or Information Science Graduate study program.

Submission Deadlines for Graduate Studies

Spring Semester • November 1

Summer Semester • May1

Fall Semester • July 1
